KVL: Everyone is Welcome Here

In October, Katonah Village Library (along with community vendors/individuals) took part in the Inclusive Initiative's neurodivergent training, provided by Anderson Center for Autism. The

library's goal is for everyone with neurodivergence, including autism, to feel that the library is a welcoming space.

- -The Children's Library now has a social story available for children to look at when they come to the library. (A social story is a short description of a particular situation, event or activity, which includes information about what to expect in a situation and why.)
- -The Children's Room and Main Floor offer noise canceling headphones and fidget/stim toys and sensory objects.
- -The Library continues to hold a once a month Monday morning Sensory Friendly Movie in collaboration with The ARC Westchester
